Sam Cawthorn is the 2009 Young Australian of the Year for Tasmania.

In October 2006, Sam was involved in a head-on collision with a semitrailer, and was pronounced dead. After resuscitation he faced severe injuries including the <u>amputation</u> of his right arm above the elbow and severe damage to his right leg. Initially distraught by the prospect he may never walk again he maintained a strong mental attitude and conceptualized "Be Motivated" during his nine months of <u>rehabilitation</u>. Sam is a thought leader and CEO of Empowering Enterprises. He is an expert in not only bouncing back but bouncing forward. He strongly emphasises the importance of a healthy mental attitude and not allowing excuses to hinder achievements.



Our students bandaged their right hand to put themselves in Sam's shoes and experience what it is like not to have a right hand. Two hours was long enough for most but Kiarra managed a full 24 hours. Well done!
