CAR PARKING WHEN VISITING OUR SCHOOL

On Monday morning a very serious incident happened in the staff car park where a parent was pinned against a post by a reversing car driven by a non-staff member. We have asked repeatedly that parents **do not drive into either of the staff car-parks to drop off their children**. It endangers everybody's safety and we have been so lucky that, to this point, none of our children have been badly hurt. We have just witnessed how easily it could happen.

The designated car park beside the hall for people with disabilities is only to be used as a drop off point by authorised and/or approved people.

We have sought advice from Council and now feel we have no alternative but to **note the licence numbers** of any cars illegally present in the staff car-park and pass them on to the police.

PLEASE, drop your children at the bottom of the hill in the bus bay and walk up the designated path in safety.
