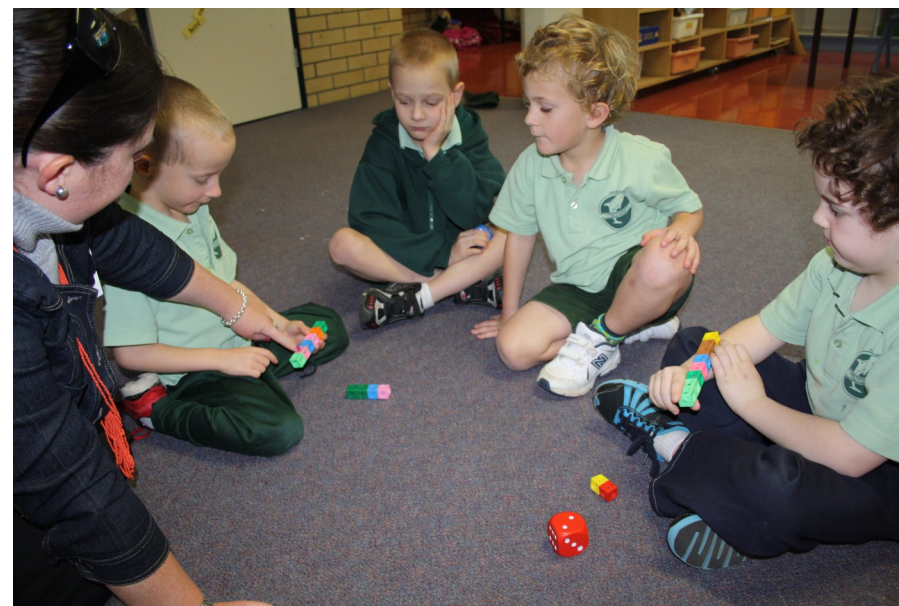

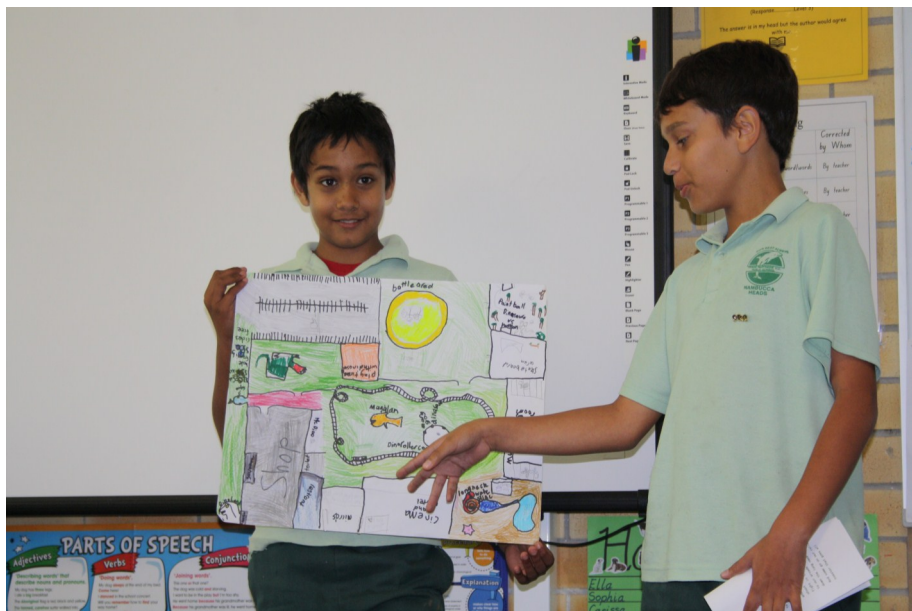

## Do you have a child in Year 4, 5 or 6

In 2001 the government introduced the 'First Child Tax Offset'. This was one of the first types of baby bonuses introduced but unlike today's Baby Bonus Schemes it was not given much media exposure and was confusing. Surprisingly many Australians did not know about it and have NOT claimed any benefits. If your child was born between 1 July 2001 and 30 June 2004 you may be eligible to receive an entitlement. The Tax office has now put a deadline on making a claim.
