Frank Partridge VC Public School would like to invite all children enrolling in kindergarten in 2017 to our Kickstart Orientation Program. The Kickstart program provides an opportunity for you and your child to meet staff and to become acquainted with what Frank Partridge VC School aims to offer your child academically, socially, physically and emotionally.

There is no obligation to enrol your child at our school, as Kickstart can be considered a trial for the year ahead. Our staff will be able to advise any parents or carers of a child's readiness for school after they have completed the 4 session program.

The 'Kickstart' program runs across 4 sessions starting on Friday 21/10/2016 and aims to provide a smooth and happy transition into Kindergarten. Attending the program will enable your child to develop confidence and a positive attitude towards their first year at school. Each week children will be introduced to new aspects of school life. We will go on tours of the school and the children will meet their buddies for 2017. There will be a theme each week and the children will be given a variety of tasks to enable teachers to assess your child's abilities and readiness for school.

There will be a parent information session on the last day of the program (Friday 2/12/2016) and all parents are welcome to join us for this session. At the session you will be able to ask questions, order uniforms and learn about our literacy and numeracy programs.

Our Kickstart program starts each week at 9.30am in the Kindergarten rooms and we ask that parents or carers arrange to pick their child up from 'Kickstart' between 11.30 and 12pm
