We will get to the bottom of all issues as reported to us and we will act to ensure all of our students feel safe and comfortable at school. To do this we need your help. Do not hesitate to contact myself or your child's teacher immediately should you have any concerns, even if they are minor. Thank you so much to all of our parents and carers who have shown faith in myself and our staff and allowed us to sort through the many complex issues that arise as part of your child's schooling. It is this teamwork that will ensure all of our students feel comfortable and safe in their learning environment each and every day.
