Stage 1 and 2 students will be enjoying these tasty treats this week and discussing how food works in their body. They have covered a great deal of learning this term starting with ear health and the importance of hearing in learning. Nutritional food is so essential to a developing child and it's great to see less processed, packaged food in the lunch boxes and more crunching and munching of whole foods. Do some baking with your child these holidays...you'll be surprised how much they can tell you!

Banana, berry & yoghurt breakfast muffins the kids will love!



Ingredients

2 cups wholemeal self raising flour
1 cup rolled oats
1/4 cup honey
2 eggs
3/4 cup natural or Greek style low fat yoghurt
2 ripe bananas
1/2 cup fresh or frozen berries
1/4 cup olive oil
2 tbs chia seeds (optional)
1 tsp ground cinnamon
1/2 tsp natural vanilla essence
Olive oil or butter for greasing tin

Instructions

- 1) Preheat oven to 180c
- 2) In a large bowl combine all dry ingredients and stir well
- 3) In a small bowl, mix eggs, honey, olive oil, yoghurt and vanilla
- 4) Add egg mixture to the dry ingredients and stir well
- 5) Add mashed banana and berries and gently fold through (it's ok if the mixture is lumpy)
- 6) Use olive oil or butter to grease tray
- 7) Spoon mixture into prepared tray
- 8) Place in oven and allow to cook for 20-30 minutes
- 9) Test that they are fully cooked by gently inserting a skewer into one of the muffins before removing from oven.
